Highlights of the Month



Press Conference: Earlier this month, PAG held a press conference at the Governor's Conference Room in Adelup to announce the signing of HR4899 which gives the Port \$50 million for its Modernization Program. After the failed attempt to acquire a TIGER grant through the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009, Congress Woman Madeline Bordallo requested the Obama Administration to include much needed funding for the Port through HR 4899. Funds will be managed by MARAD once deposited into the Port Enterprise Improvement Fund.



A/C Unit: The replacement of the Port's old air conditioning unit in the Administration building has been completed. However, the unit will not go on line until duct cleaning by Molecular Construction & Development has been completed.

In July, the old 40 ton A/C unit was shut down so replacement work can take place. JRN Air conditioning & Refrigeration Inc. installed the new unit under



the supervision of Building Facility Superintendent Joe Ragasa. The old unit serviced the Admin building for over 30 years.



Gordon Lowe Appreciation: Management recently presented Mr. Gordon Lowe with a certification from the Governor and Lt. Governor recognizing him for the service he's provided over the past 5 years as the Director of the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command,
