FIRST AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT

THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT consisting of a firm fixed priced contract awarded under IFB-PAG-001-26 and P.O. 21448-OP (hereinafter "Agreement") was made and entered on March 5, 2026, by and between the Port Authority of Guam (PAG) whose address is 1026 Cabras Highway Suite 201 Piti, GU 96925 (hereinafter "***AGENCY***") and Pacific Petroleum Trading Corporation duly licensed to do business in Guam, whose address is 220 E. Harmon Industrial Park Rd. Tamuning, GU 96913, (hereinafter the "**Contractor**"). For purposes of the Agreement and this First Amendment of Agreement (hereinafter "**First Amendment**"), the foregoing entities may also be referred to collectively as "**the Parties.**"

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Port Authority of Guam previously engaged the services of the Contractor to supply lubricants and degreasers (hereinafter "**the Project**") under IFB PAG-001-26 (hereinafter, the "**IFB**"); and,

WHEREAS, the Contractor agreed to furnish, perform and deliver all supplies, materials and services as provided in the Agreement and the IFB; and the IFB contained a provision for indefinite quantity and indefinite delivery; and,

WHEREAS, there are goods and services that require(s) performance under the Agreement, and it has been ascertained that the Amendment of the Agreement is more practical and advantageous than the issuance of a new competitive procurement under the current circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, the PAG and the Contractor in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth in the Agreement and this document, agree to enter into this First Amendment for the substitution of parts as follows:

Item No. 1 Hydraulic Oil to read from: ZIC SUPERVIS AW 32 to now read: ZIC SUPERVIS AW 46



This First Amendment incorporates all of the applicable terms and conditions of the Agreement, and shall be performed on the same terms, conditions, and price as in effect under the Agreement, at no additional cost to the PAG or the government of Guam.
