Port conducts assessments of facilities

Piti, Guam, October 11, 2023: Assessments are ongoing at the Port Authority of Guam following the passage of Typhoon Bolaven.

The Port remains in Port Heavy Weather Condition Zulu which is a designation by the U.S. Coast Guard Captain of the Port. In this designation, the port and marinas remain completely closed to any incoming traffic, and all cargo and bunker operations.

"Our Port Strong employees returned to work this morning at 10AM after the Governor declared Condition of Readiness 4," said Port General Manager Rory J. Respicio. "Their focus has been to prepare the Port to reopen once we have determined that the Port is ready in conjunction with the Captain of the Port's all clear."

Preliminary assessments conducted at first light revealed Port facilities sustained minor damage from Typhoon Bolaven. Assessments will continue throughout the day to include the condition of the gantry cranes.
